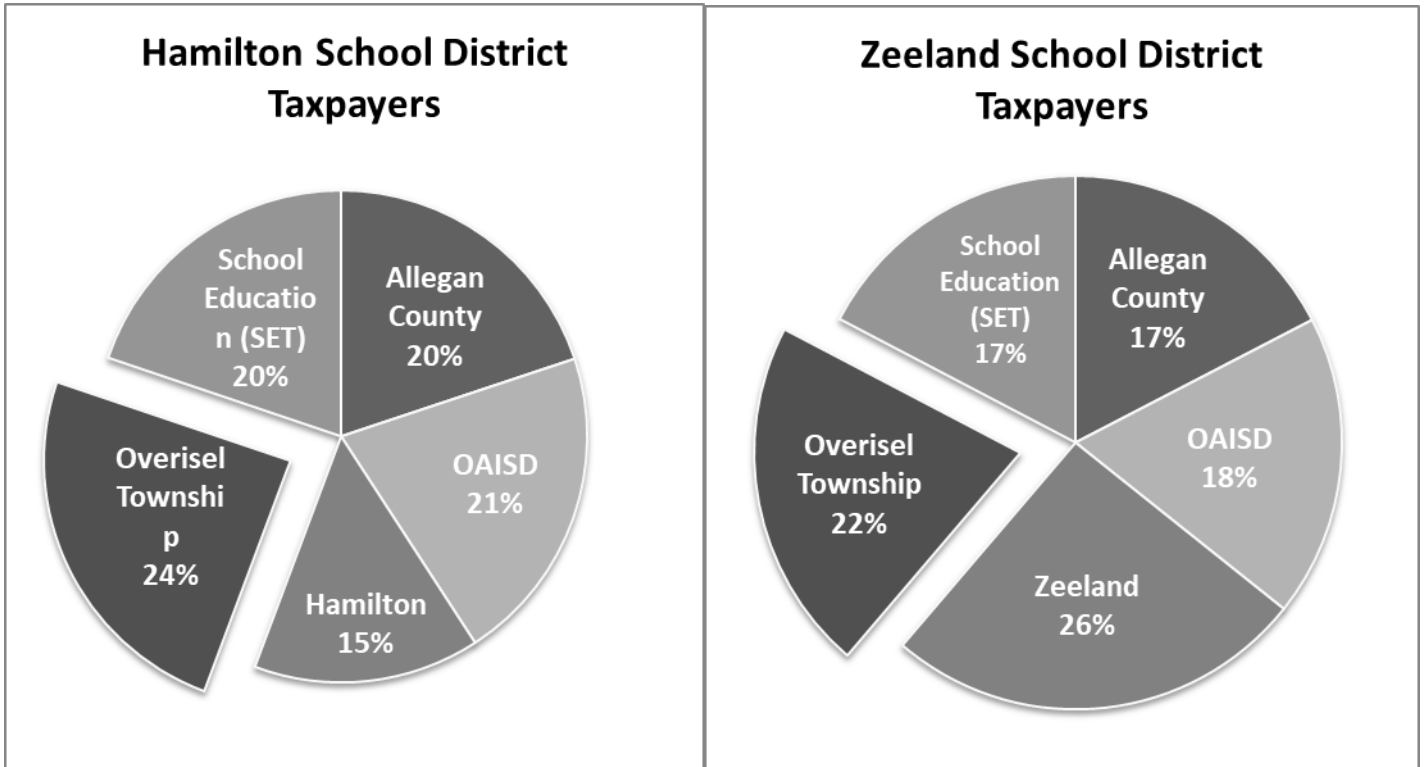
TRANSFER STATION INFO—

To use the transfer station, you must buy a “card” which costs \$20.00. Township residents can purchase a card at the Transfer Station. It’s open the **1st and 3rd Saturday** each month 8AM to 5PM. (Closed holidays, Jan. and Feb.) 1/4th mile N of Sandy-view School on 46th. Yard waste, asphalt shingles, major appliances, tires or oil base paints are **not accepted**.

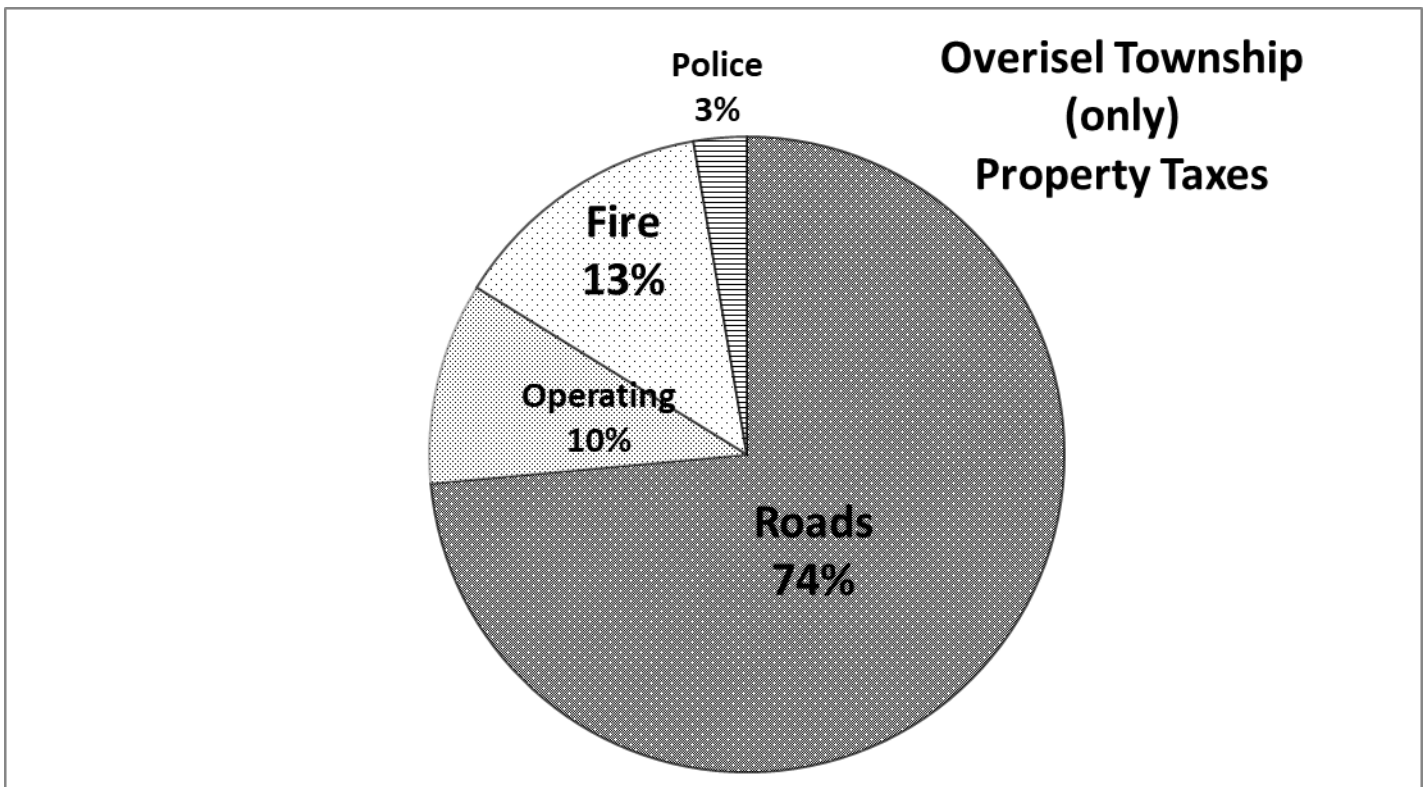
Please use Paper Gators--
Oakland CRC , Overisel RC and Bentheim Elementary School have **Paper Gators** (located in parking lots). These bins accept newsprint, catalogs, magazines, junk mail, phone books, office, school paper, hard and soft cover books. (**NO** plastic, metal, trash, glass, cardboard or paperboard -grocery item boxes.) **Supporting area Paper Gators saves taxpayer money as the township pays to recycle paper.**

Your Property Taxes PRE 2019



This graph shows a break down by percentage of how your property tax money is split between the various entities. It may be easier to think of like this, using above graphs; if you had paid one dollar of property tax each year, the Allegan County fund would get 20 cents or 17 cents (Hamilton or Zeeland respectively).



This graph shows the various ways that your property taxes are used in Overisel Township. This is equal to 24 cents or 22 cents of every dollar of your property tax bill.
